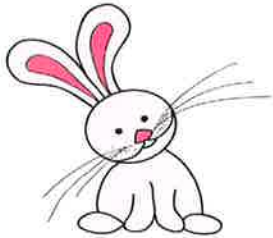


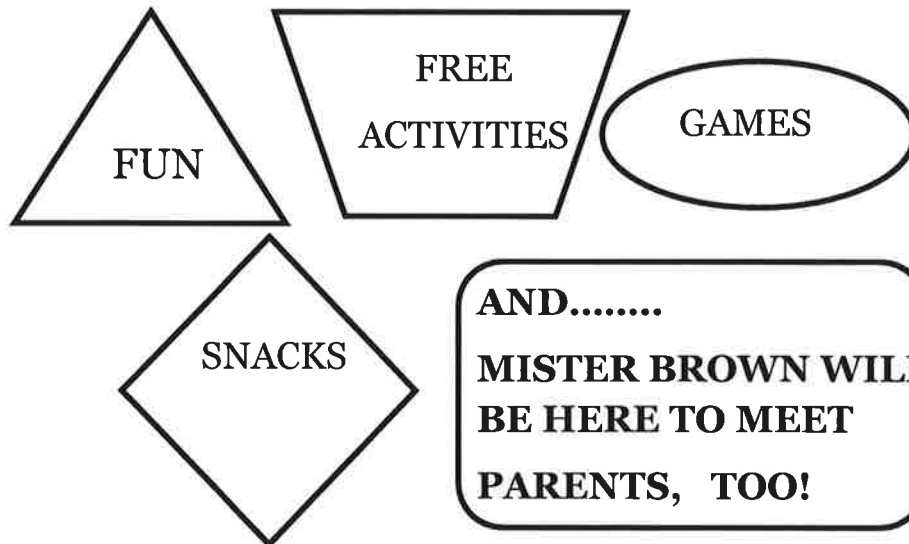

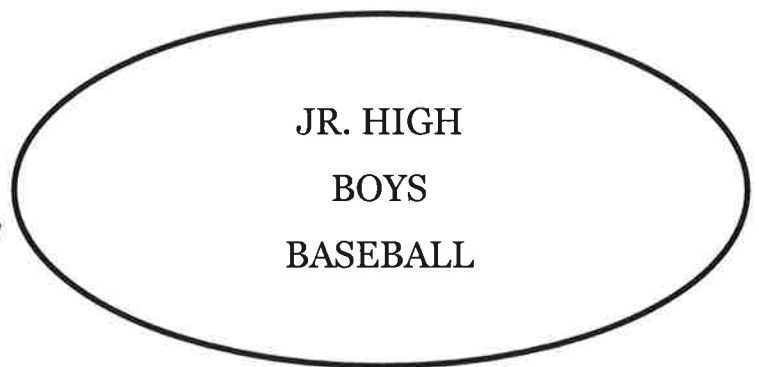

## GEAR UP AT BSA

GEAR UP (Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs) is a grant from the US Department of Education that is designed to increase the number of students who are prepared to enter and succeed in college after high school. Our school has a GEAR UP advisor working with the 6th and 7th grade students that will follow them through high school and through their first year of college. GEAR UP provides early awareness about college and provides support activities such as: tutoring, mentoring, academic preparation for college, financial planning for college, and college scholarships to improve

access to higher education for low income students and families. **We are very thankful to have received the GEAR UP grant to help support our students in their transition from junior high to high school and into college! 6th and 7th grade students will be meeting with the GEAR UP advisor soon.**
